S. Parker Gilbert, who led Morgan Stanley & Company through the greatest period of growth in the firm's history, said yesterday that he would retire as chairman by the end of the year.

Mr. Gilbert has had an extremely close relationship with Morgan Stanley throughout his life, with ties that go back to the House of Morgan.

His father, S. Parker Gilbert, joined J. P. Morgan as a partner, but died in 1938. Years later, Mr. Gilbert's mother married Harold Stanley, a J. P. Morgan partner and a founder of Morgan Stanley.

Mr. Gilbert joined the firm in 1960 after graduation from Yale and service in Army intelligence.

WIFE - Margaret Jouett Menefee

Margaret is the daughter of Richard Jouett Menefee & Elizabeth Williamson.

Granddaughter of Richard Hickman Menefee & Sarah Bell Jouett.

Richard Hickman Menefee b. December 4, 1809 d. February 21, 1841 -- US Congressman. Elected to represent Kentucky's 11th District in the United States House of Representatives, serving from 1837 to 1839. Also served as a Member of the Kentucky State Legislature from 1836 to 1837. He & his wife are buried in the Cave Hill Cemetery, Louisville, Jefferson Co., KY

Sarah Bell Jouett (1815-1898) - Daughter of Matthew Harris Jouett, b. April 22, 1788 d. August 10, 1827 Matthew Harris Jouett was an Artist & Portrait painter. Attributed painter of 334 portraits and miniatures. Subjects included Marquis de LaFayette, Henry Clay, Gen. George Rogers Clark, Kentucky Governor Isaac Shelby and Virginia Governor James McDowell. His father was Capt. John "Jack" Jouett Jr. who has been called the "Paul Revere of the South," as he delivered warnings that the British were coming, saving Thomas Jefferson and the entire Virginia legislature from capture in 1781.

S. Parker Gilbert Rites Saturday Overwork Declared Factor in Death of Banker and Former Treasury Aide
Funeral services for S. Parker Gilbert, former Under Secretary of the United States Treasury and partner in J. P. Morgan & Co., who died yesterday, will be held at 10 a.m. Saturday in the Church of the Heavenly Rest, 90th St. and 5th Ave., Manhattan. Burial will be private in Southampton.

Mr. Gilbert's death was caused in part by overwork, according to one of his close associates. "There cannot be much question," he said, "that the very heavy burdens which Mr. Gilbert carried in the Treasury at Washington during the war years, and his further very onerous responsibilities during his years as Agent General of Reparations had seriously undermined his constitution."

Surviving Mr. Gilbert are his widow, three children, Seymour Parker Gilbert 3d, Louise Todd Gilbert and John Jouett Gilbert, and a brother and a sister. Mr. Gilbert had homes at 30 Sutton Place, Manhattan, and at Southampton.

Joined Law Firm - After leaving the Treasury Department, Mr. Gilbert joined the law firm of Cravath & Henderson, and was with this firm only a short time before being appointed agent general.

Born in Bloomfield, N. J., he was graduated from elementary school at 11, from high school at 15, and
